

# DIY HOME ENERGY SURVEY CHECKLIST

Try doing a basic DIY home energy audit! Walk round each room in turn and note down what you find.

Here's a checklist of things to consider along the way:

<b>Insulation</b>	Inspect the loft, external walls and ground floor, if accessible. Look for insulation around the hot water tank and pipes.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Draught proofing</b>	Check around doors, windows and other openings for draughts and gaps. Don't forget the loft hatch, letter box and keyholes.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Heating</b>	Make sure your boiler, radiators or other heat sources are working efficiently, and check that heating controls, timers and thermostats are set correctly.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Lighting</b>	Check that all lighting is fitted with efficient LED bulbs, including in ovens, extractor hoods, and external lights.	<input type="checkbox"/>

Armed with your energy efficiency information, you can start planning what action to take.
